4.0 Team Reports

- 4.4 DB stated that the HD 'A' team were doing okay, but lacked experience on the pitch. The players generally want to stay together for the remainder of this season however. It was suggested that maybe the current U16 team could be invited to train with the HD 'A' team to help their transition to open age football next season. DB said that this was a good idea which he would look into.

5.0 Development

- 5.1 TH, MS and RB had arranged a meeting with the cricket club to be held on Tuesday 24th November. The aim of this meeting is to fully understand the cricket club's plans, to gauge how it will affect the football club, and to ensure that we are getting what we want from the proposal. It was agreed that we need to clarify how many changing rooms are included, whether a pitch barrier has been allowed for, and to understand what is required in terms of maintenance.
- 5.2 RB stated that he had spoken to Philip Rhodes from the WRCAFL about a pitch barrier. Philip stated that for the Premier Division he was happy with a fixed barrier down two sides of the pitch and a rope barrier behind the goals as a temporary measure. They would also be open to the idea of ground sharing. Philip also mentioned that Football Foundation funding was available should we wish to pursue it.

6.0 Finance

6.1 TH produced an estimate of the Club's expected financial position at the end of the 2015/16 season, which was based on this season's finances to date and anticipated fund raising in 2016. This showed that the Club should just about break even, but highlighted that should we wish to pay a new manager for the WR team then we would have to put more effort into fundraising.
